

2024 RCC GOLF EVENTS

Golf Formats for RCC Tournaments:

-The two kinds of golfing events scheduled during the golf season are Match Play and Stroke Play events. Details for these are below:

-Match play format 1:

-Two players engage in a stipulated round of golf, typically 18 holes in length. A hole is won by the player who puts the ball in with the least number of strokes. The hole is halved if each player takes the same number of

strokes. The player who wins the most holes wins the match

-Stroke play format 2:

-Sometimes referred to as medal play, the golfer with the least number of strokes in the entire round wins

Season Long Golf Event Match Play Brackets: (The deadline to sign up is early May)

Men's and Women's Stone Memorial:

-This handicap tournament is a match-play event open to all golf members. Matches are played throughout the golfing season. The player with the lower net score wins the hole. A game is won by the player leading by several holes more significant than the number remaining to be played. \$10 per player entry.

Men's and Women's Two-Person Best Ball:

-This match-play event is similar to the Stone Memorial. The difference is that two players make up a team. This is one of Reedsburg Country Club's most popular golfing events. The tournament is open to all golf members. Matches are played throughout the golfing season. Handicaps are applied, and the team with the single lowest net score wins the hole. A game is won by the team led by several holes greater than the number of holes remaining to be played. \$10 per player entry

Men's and Women's Two-Person Scramble:

-This match-play event is similar to the two-person best ball. The tournament is open to all golf members. Matches are played throughout the golfing season.

Handicaps are applied, and the pair with the single lowest net score wins the hole. A match is won by the team led by several holes greater than the remaining holes to be played.

\$10 per player entry

Men's Presidents Cup:

-All men with golf memberships are eligible for this match-play tournament. Matches for this event will be played throughout the golfing season. Handicaps do not apply in this event. The player with the low actual score wins a given hole. A match is won by the player leading by a number of holes greater than the number remaining to be played. This event will have two brackets to group by similar handicaps. \$10 per player entry

Men's 2 Club:

-All men with golf memberships are eligible for this match-play tournament. Matches for this event will be played throughout the golfing season. Handicaps do not apply in this event. Players will choose only 2 clubs to use during each match. The player with the low actual score wins a given hole. A game is won by the player leading by several holes greater than the number of holes remaining to be played. This event will have two brackets to group by similar handicaps. \$10 per player entry

COMPETITIVE GOLF EVENTS

Men's Invitational:

-Teams consist of two players- one member and one guest. Combined handicaps flight the teams.

Each flight will consist of 6 teams. Each team will play 27 holes on Saturday and 18 holes on Sunday.

Each team will play the five other teams in their flight over the two days of golf. Matches consist of 9 holes of best ball match play. A total of one point will be awarded in each game. The team with the

most points in the flight will play the other winners in a Sunday shootout to determine the overall winner. Dinner alongside a Whiskey and Cigar Bar on Saturday Night

-Dates: July 13th & 14th

-Cost: Member Entry included in Full Golf Membership

-Guest Fee: TBD

Holzmiller Cup:

-This event is a favorite of all RCC Golf Members. Captains draft members to represent teams.

Four golf formats are used: Scramble, alternate shot, best ball, and individual match play. Eighteen holes are played each day, and teammates are repaired each day. A point system is used to determine the overall winner. Pari-mutuel wagering is available. This is one of RCC's most popular men's and ladies' events

-Dates: July 27th & 28th

-Cost: Member Entry included in Full Golf Membership

Ladies Invitational:

-Women from area golf clubs will be invited to spend this 'Ladies' Day at the Reedsburg Country Club.

The format will change from year to year. Lunch and Golf is followed by dinner and the awarding of prizes for the day.

-Date: July 30th

-Cost: Member Entry included with Full Golf Membership

-Guest Entry: TBD

Couples Championship:

-Couples who are golf members of RCC are eligible for this tournament. Couples who are unmarried may wish to compete in this tournament for prizes, but the Club Championship Title will be awarded to a husband-wife team. This is an 18-hole event. Individual handicaps are subtracted from the final scores. The couple's scores are combined for both gross and net

totals

-Date: August 4th

-Cost: TBD

Men's/Senior's/Ladies Club Championship:

-This stroke play event is open to all amateurs with an RCC golf membership. This is a 36-hole event. Although handicaps are not used to determine winners, they do choose the flight in which a player will participate

-Dates: August 17th & 18th

-Cost: Member Entry included with Golf Membership

RCC Cup:

-The RCC Cup is a season-long event for which members will earn points in specific events throughout the golf season. Men's and 'Ladies' Divisions. Players earn points based on their finish in RCC Cup Events.

MEMBER GOLF DAYS

Tuesday Ladies Day:

-Ladies Day Tee Times start at 11:30 AM. Do you have a group to play with or are looking to meet other ladies at the club - then come on out and join in the golf on this day. We will host an optional golf event each week. The events vary each week. At least once a month, a special event is held where players are mixed into different groups. All members are welcome to play.

Wednesday Men's Day:

-The Men's Day Tee times start at 11:40 AM. Pro Shop will hold a weekly golf game that can vary through the summer. All members are welcome to play.

Saturday/Sunday Morning Member Mixer:

-The event starts at 8:30 AM each Saturday and Sunday. Players are divided into teams. The event entry is \$20.00 with a total cash payout. All members and their guests are welcome to play in the event. They need an established handicap.
